Thanks to one couple, the organization now has a home in Baldwinsville. Tara and Dave McKenney rescued their black lab, Gracie, shortly

after hurricane Katrina. Many southern states lack proper spay and neuter laws and that has led to a severe over population. "It's a cruel and slow and a very horrific death for the dogs. So there's an urgency to save the dogs. There's an extreme over population and once they're put in the shelter sometimes they're only given three days until their gassed", said Tara McKenney. In the past five years, Labs 4 Rescue has saved more than five thousand dogs. "We can't imagine having such a bright loving loyal dog be destroyed for no reason besides there being just to many of them and it happens every day", said McKenney.
